

Required Quarantine Informational Sheet

Quarantine Obligations:

When a student is placed into a quarantine space, either on or off campus, they are required to adhere to the following—

- Students will be required to remain in the room to which they are assigned (either in their academic year space or in another space deemed by the Office of Residence Life unless an emergency occurs).
- Meals will be arranged for students who are quarantining. If a student has a meal plan, they will receive their meals to their quarantine space and it will be charged to the meal plan account. If a student does not have a meal plan and they opt into meals, they will receive a \$23/day charge to their student account.
 - Weekday Meals will be delivered at 8:30am, 11:30am and 4:30pm (Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner)
 - Weekend Meals will be delivered at 10:30am and 4:30pm (Brunch and Dinner)
- There is to be no in-person socializing with other students.
- Depending on a student's class schedule, the quarantine may interfere with attendance to in-person classes. The student will be solely responsible to work with faculty to take their classes remotely and/or stay current with assignments.

Contact information for On-Campus Emergency Support:

Should a student in quarantine need to contact a college representative for support they can call the Area Coordinator on call. The contact information for the AC on call is, 518-301-3488. At that time, the Area Coordinator will contact Security or other offices if necessary.

Students should also call the AC on Call for any facility concerns or inquiries.

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Quarantine Procedures (Off Campus):

When a student had to Quarantine off campus, they must do the following:

1. Students will be instructed that they need to be out of their Residence Hall by 5pm the day they receive their letter.
2. An email will be sent to Tara Steelman of Student's IDs that will need to be shut off.
3. Student must drop their room key to the Office of Residence Life at 204 Partridge Street between 8:30pm-4:30pm. If it is after 4:30pm, they need to call professional staff at 518-301-3488 to meet them at The Office of Residence Life to drop off their key.
4. The Student must Quarantine off campus for 14 days and must submit a new COVID-19 test result to covidresults@strose.edu

When a student is returning to campus from Quarantine, they must do the following:

1. The students will receive a confirmation email from covidresults@strose.edu that we have received their negative COVID results.
2. An email will be sent to Tara Steelman to turn the student's access back on.
3. The Residence Life Office will reach out to the student about returning back to campus
 - a. Student will need to schedule appointment with the Residence Life Office through the Navigate Office between 8:30pm-4:30pm.
 - b. If it is after 4:30pm, they need to call professional staff at 518-301-3448 to meet them at The Office of Residence Life to drop off their key.
4. Professional Staff will give them their key.

Quarantine Procedures (On Campus):

When a student has to Quarantine on campus, they must do the following:

1. Office of Residence Life will work with Tara Steelman to give them access to Quarantine Space.
2. To pick up their key students must come to the Office of Residence Life at 204 Partridge Street between 8:30pm-4:30pm. If it is after 4:30pm, they need to call professional staff at 518-301-3488 to meet them at The Office of Residence Life to drop off their key.
3. The student must Quarantine in their on-campus Quarantine space for 14 days.

When a student has completed their on-campus Quarantine, they must do the following:

1. Student will receive an email about moving into their semester space.
2. The Residence Life Office will reach out to the student about returning back to campus
 - a. Student will need to schedule appointment with the Residence Life Office through the Navigate Office between 8:30pm-4:30pm.
 - b. If it is after 4:30pm, they need to call professional staff at 518-301-3448 to meet them at The Office of Residence Life to drop off their key.
3. Professional Staff will give them their key.
